

Diorama display can have any theme, as long as it is family-friendly. Examples include: books, movies, television shows, musicals, historical scenes, science fiction, you name it!

- Diorama parts should all fit inside a box the size of a shoebox. You may remove one or more sides of the box if you wish.
- All visible parts of the diorama should be decorated, including the outside of the box.
- All characters in your scene should be made using Peeps.
- Open to all ages. Limit one entry per person or team. For teams, choose the category of your oldest team member.
- Drop off your work (include entry form) beginning April 1 and view the exhibition from April 5-30 in the first-floor display case located next to the self-check-in machine.
- There will be prizes for each age group, along with a Peeples Choice Award. Prizes include Peeps toys, books and candy.

• Entries can be picked up May 1 - 9, otherwise they will be discarded, unless arrangements are made for a later pickup date.

We will do our best to keep your diorama safe, but the library is not responsible for any damage to your diorama. By entering the diorama contest, you are giving Mead Public Library permission to display your diorama in the library, take pictures of your creation and share them online.
